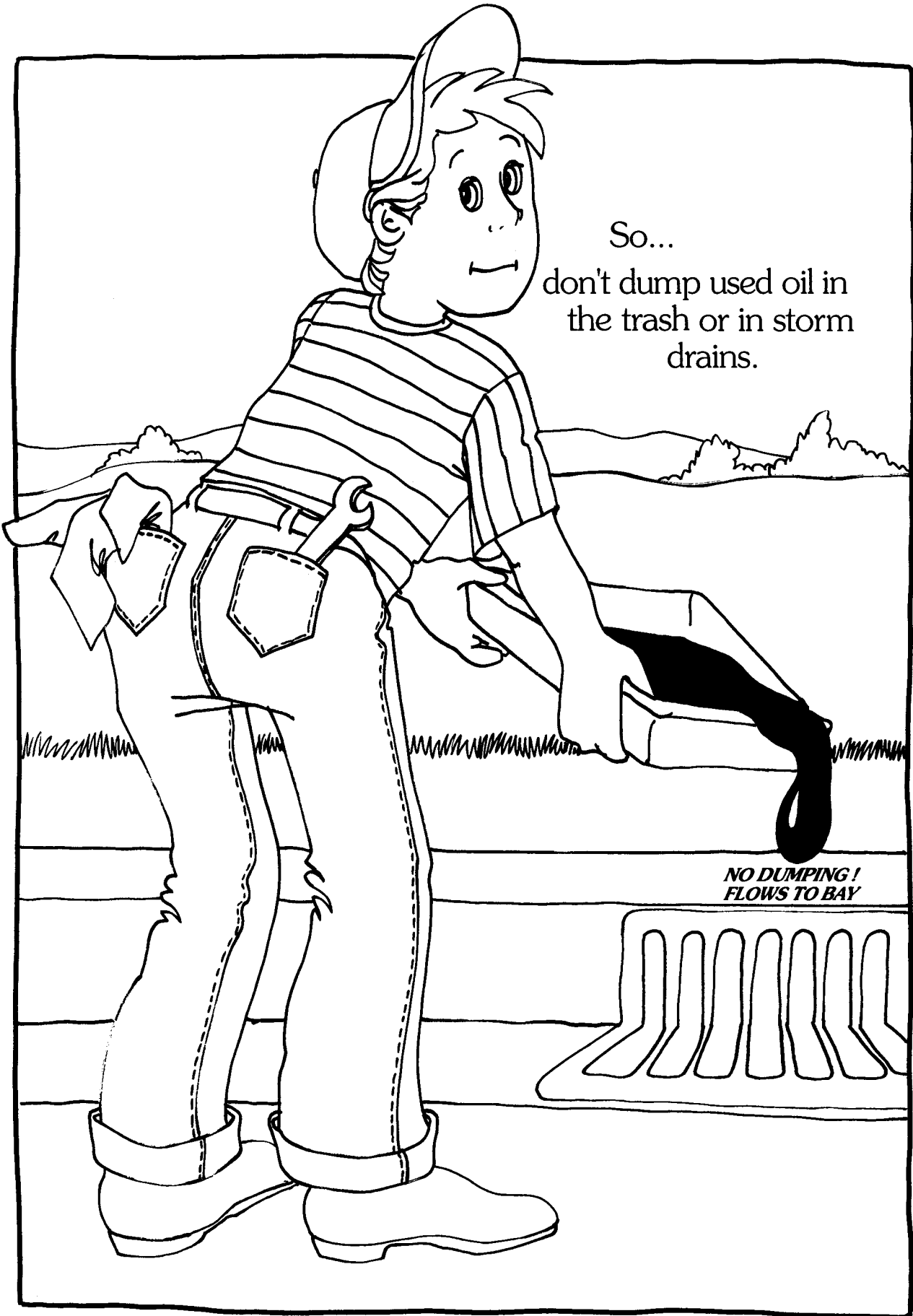


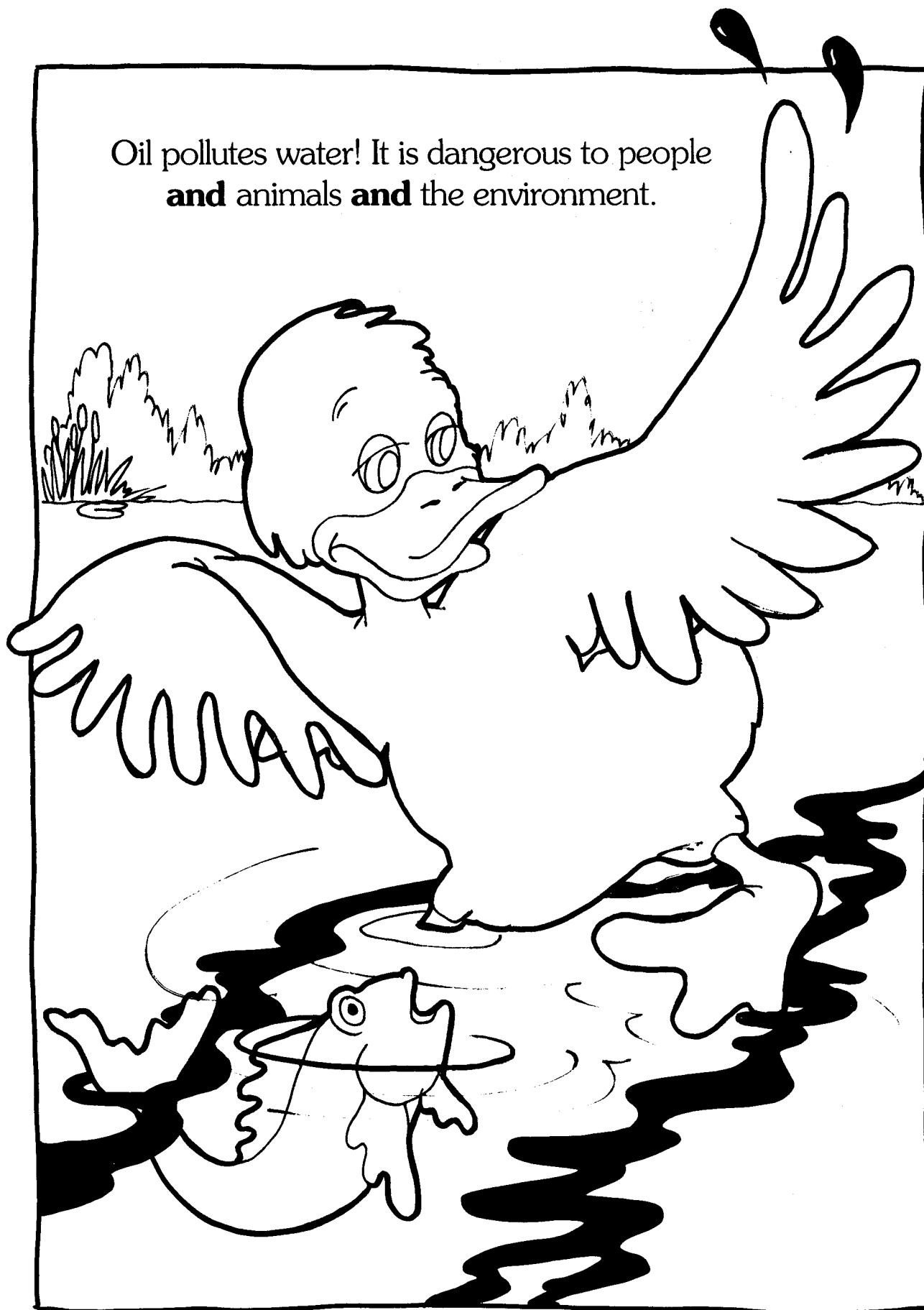
Used oil **must** be recycled. Did you know that

250,000 **gallons** of drinking water?



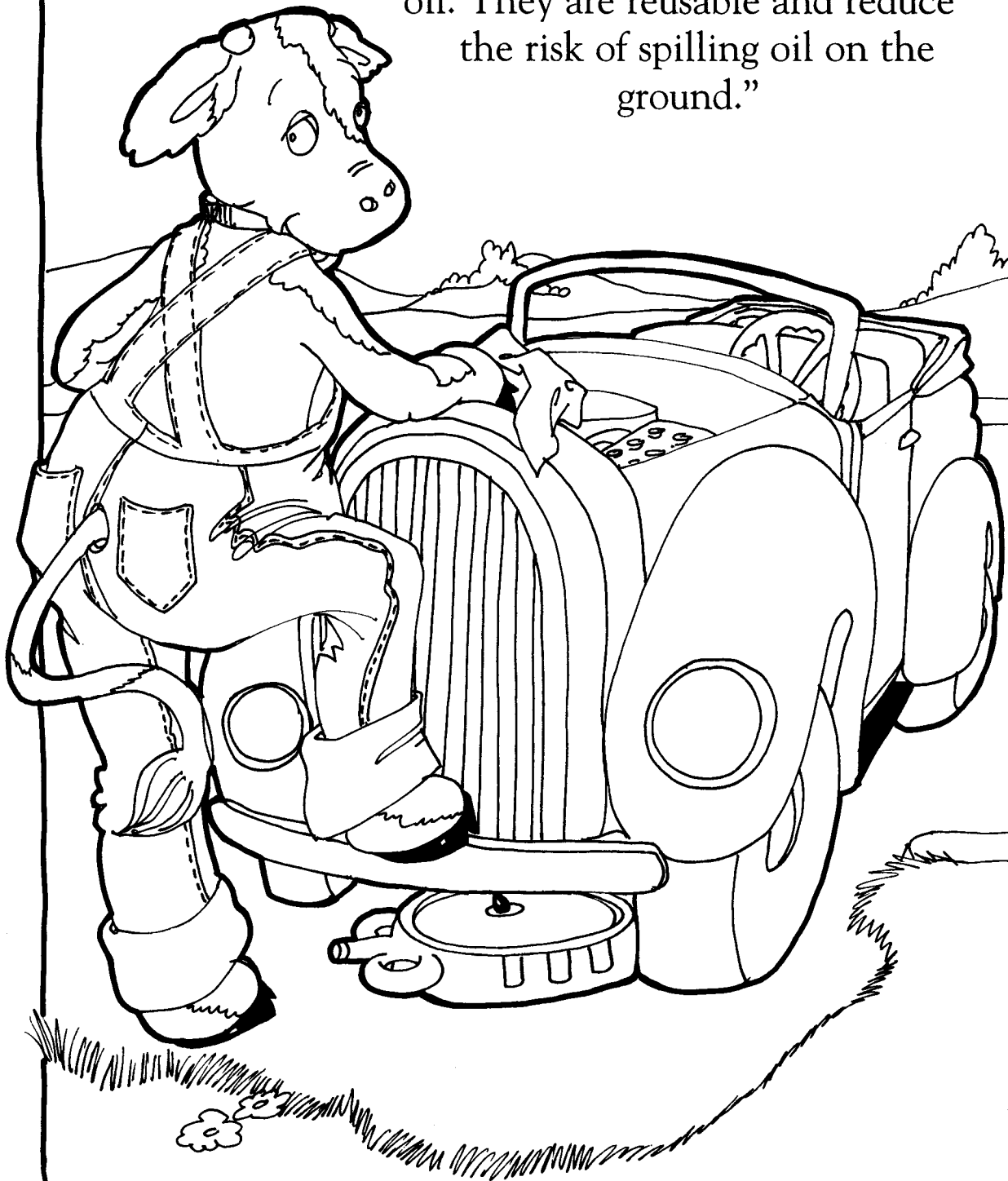

**and** animals **and** the environment.

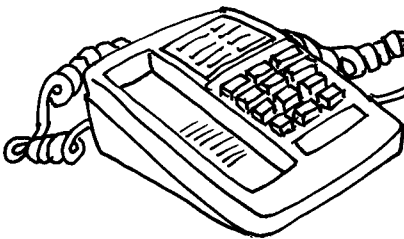
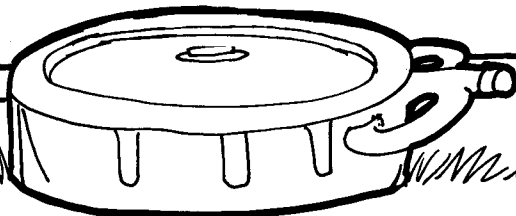


“Be sure to use an Oil recycling Container to catch oil. They are reusable and reduce the risk of spilling oil on the ground.”





Used oil can be picked up at your own curbside. Just call your garbage company to see if this service is in your area.

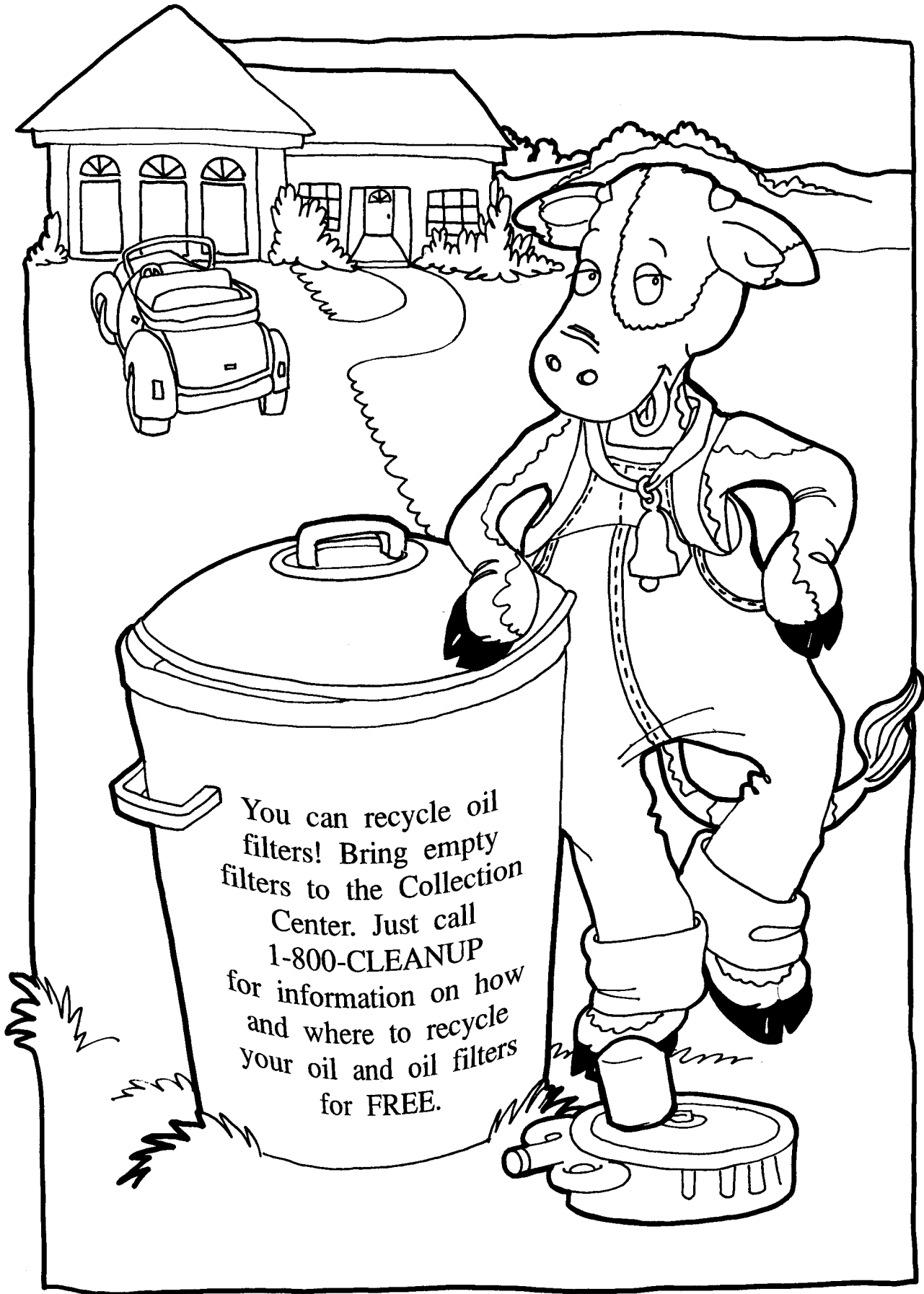


OR... You can also take used oil to a
